- <sup>23</sup> Ages ago I was set up,  
at the first, before the beginning of the earth.
- <sup>24</sup> When there were no depths I was brought forth,

- <sup>26</sup> when he had not yet made earth and fields,  
or the world’s first bits of soil.

<sup>29</sup> when he assigned to the sea its limit,  
so that the waters might not transgress his command,

and I was daily his delight,  
rejoicing before him always,  
<sup>31</sup> rejoicing in his inhabited world  
and delighting in the human race.

endurance produces character, and character produces hope, <sup>5</sup> and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.
