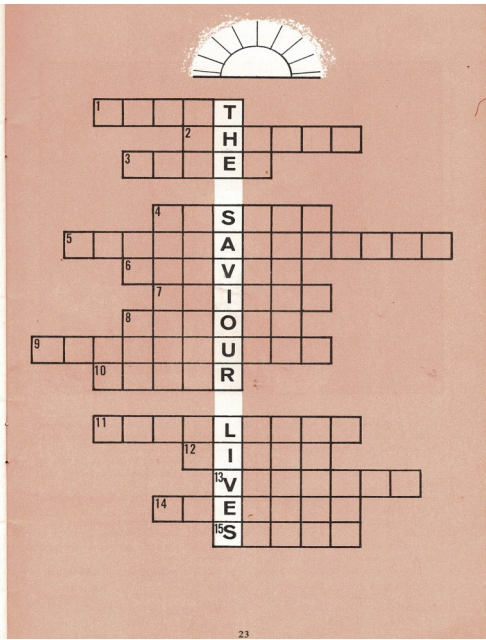

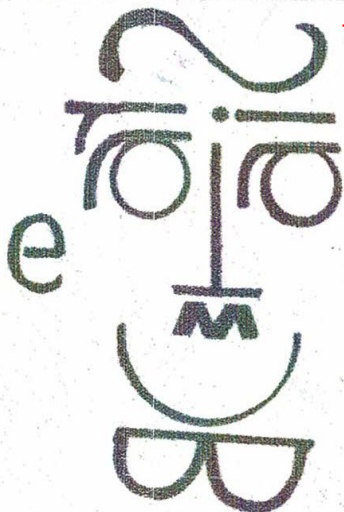

- The \_\_\_\_\_ had been rolled away from the tomb (Luke 24:2).



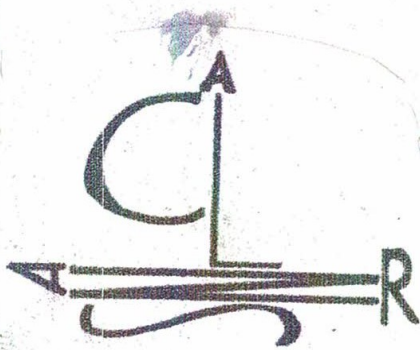

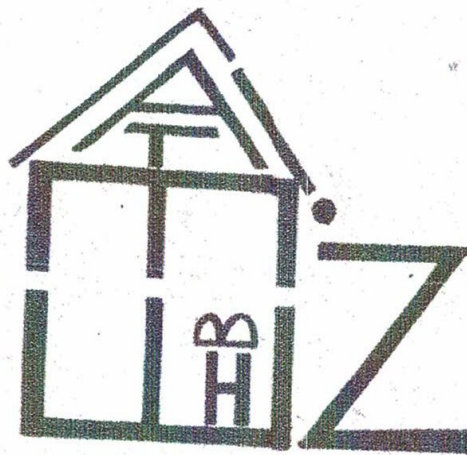
